



2. In order to be able to locate scriptures (my life) wherever I may be I need either:
  - A Bible with a mini-concordance at the back of it (a concordance is an alphabetical index of bible words), or
  - A hand held computer Bible (from Radio shack starting at \$50)

Note I: For the real study of God's word I will need either:

- A Strong's exhaustive concordance (Dr. Strong's alphabetical list of all the bible words – including his dictionary of all the original Hebrew and Greek words – a prior knowledge of these two languages is not necessary to use his dictionary) or
- A Bible software program for PC's or Mac's that uses Strong's reference numbers. (e.g. Godspeed by Bryan G. Moore).

Note II: Its useful to have a pen(s) clipped to my Bible or to keep a notebook and attached pen always with my Bible.
